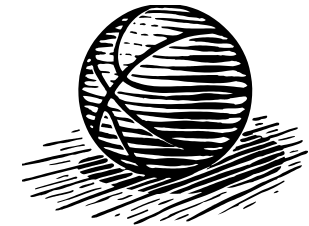

PROGRAM AND INSTRUCTION

Each camper will be coached in the fundamentals of basketball, with an emphasis on shooting, passing, and man to man defense. Players will receive feedback related to areas for improvement from their coaches.

Along with individual instruction, each camper will be placed on a team where team-play and sportsmanship is emphasized. Campers will learn several drills that they can take from camp and use to improve their skills. Additionally, campers will compete for individual and team awards.
